GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. You will be responsible to the Principal & the faculty throughout the period of education during the working hours. When free from your assignments, you are not allowed to enter the hospital wards or departments without prior permission from the Principal or teachers.
- 2. You are not allowed to bring valuables or money while joining this institution and the institution will not be responsible in any manner whatsoever for the loss of any valuables or money
- 3. During training your conduct is expected to be strictly ethical. You are expected to observe the rules of the institute of Nursing Education, Theory & Hospital. You must take healthy interests in your own studies & work & discharge your duties conscientiously so as to merit a place in the health team of the hospital & the community.
- 4. Speaking in any regional language in the institution or hospital premise is prohibited.
- 5. Any dispute arising in matters including Admission, Lessons, Examinations, and Fees etc. will be subject to JURIDICTION OF KALYAN.
- 6. A candidate must have of 80% attendance (Irrespective of the kind of absence) in theory & practical in each subject otherwise candidate will not be permit to appear for Council/University Examinations.
- 7. You will not be granted any leave of absence except 30 days of annual leave which will be decided by the management .Any other leave of absence must be made up, in order to fulfill the requirement as laid down by Maharashtra Nursing Council/Maharashtra University of Health Sciences through proper channel.
- 8. In the event of illness you are expected to report to the Principal, Teacher or if you are on duty in the hospital wards you must report to the head nurse of the hospital.
- 9. You are not allowed to receive rewards or gifts of any kind at any time from the patient or relatives.
- 10. The management may amend the above rules and regulations wherever necessary and the same shall be binding on the students.

Disciplinary measures against Ragging
